## University of Liverpool Tuesday 23rd June 2009

### Invitation to register and Call for abstracts (Deadline 22nd May 2009)

The RSC Bioorganic Group (BOG) would like to invite those involved in any aspect of biological chemistry to an informal one day symposium to be held on **Tuesday 23rd June 2009** (10.00 am to 5.00 pm).

**Aim of meeting:** There is no particular theme to this meeting and it intended to provide an opportunity for discussion of exciting and new research in any aspect of biological chemistry. The meeting is for all researchers, but in particular it provides a chance for newer academic staff members or post-doctoral workers to communicate their latest results.

**Presentations:** The meeting will consist of a series of short talks and time available to view poster presentations. The short talks (20 mins + 5 mins questions) will be entirely selected from abstract submissions. Further details about preparing talks and posters will be sent to all attendees once the registration date has passed.

**Registration:** Anyone wishing to attend the meeting should register before **22nd May 2009** by contacting Rick Cosstick - see below for contact details. The registration fee is £20 (which covers refreshments, light lunch and wine mixer at the end of the meeting) and Cheques should be made payable to "*Bioorganic Group*" and should be sent to the address below. If preferred, arrangements can be made to pay by cash on the day of the meeting, but you must register your intent to attend.

**Abstract submission:** If you wish to give a presentation (oral or poster) please submit a short abstract electronically to the same address. The abstract should be sent as a PDF and be no more than one side of A4. The Abstract should contain contact details of all contributors to the study, with the communicating author underlined.

**Programme selection:** The Bioorganic Committee will construct a programme from the submitted oral abstracts, and inform speakers by 2<sup>nd</sup> June 2009.

**Location:** The meeting will be held in The Department of Chemistry at the University of Liverpool. The Department is about 15 minutes walk from Lime Street Station and maps and directions can be found at: <http://www.liv.ac.uk/maps/index.htm> The Chemistry Department is Building 213 on the campus map and is accessed from The Green. The closest visitor's car park (car park 1) is on Mount Pleasant (next to the Metropolitan Cathedral).
